About This Role

Pecan is developing a 'Community Hub' style one-stop-shop to create a space where everyone Is welcome to find support, advice, friendship, learn new skills, find work and more. As we build the Community Hub, we are piloting one aspect of it '**Together**', which is a place to come in from the cold and engage with the hobbies and activities that are shared and co-produced; a place to make connections, explore well-being and spirituality, where everyone is seen, known, heard and valued.

Volunteers are essential to the running of Together by nurturing a sense of loving community and a culture of welcome for everyone who comes through our doors. This is an opportunity to work in the heart of Peckham where you will help us to create a safe space whilst giving back to your community, developing your existing skills, learning new skills and increasing your circle of friends.

At present we are looking for people who can volunteer time during the specified hours, although further flexibility on days and times will become available as Together becomes more established and opens more often.

The role description provides an overview of what is needed, but we encourage volunteers to feel able to bring their skills, knowledge and ideas to the café.



Main Responsibilities

- 1. Welcome visitors and work with other members of the café team to provide the best service for guests.
- **2.** Support guests to engage with activities and with the group.
- **3.** Engage in creating an open, transparent, communicative, and supportive environment for guests, volunteers, and staff, through participating and getting involved in all aspects of running Together.
- **4.** Leading/creating fun activities such as crafting or games, based on your own likes and skills.
- **5.** Setting up for each café session including getting the hot water urn ready, making sure there is milk etc.
- **6.** Taking refreshment orders, serving warm soup and roll and/or drinks and snacks to guests, cleaning/tidying up throughout and after the session.
- 7. Ensuring the café environment is clean, tidy and safe.
- **8.** Reporting any concerns (health and safety, safeguarding etc.) as soon as possible to a member of staff.
- **9.** Taking in food deliveries.
- **10.** Restocking the café.
- 11. Ensuring that waste is disposed of appropriately and that bins are cleaned at the end of the day.
- **12.** There will be other duties as they arise, and you may be asked to assist a member of staff with duties that are not outlined above.

- Are friendly, with a positive attitude towards mental health, a team player, with the ability to problem solve and show initiative
- Understand the importance of supporting people in the community
- Are calm, reliable and have a flexible attitude
